Dr Lahann Wijenayake is Head of Orthopaedic Surgery at the University of Queensland. He is a full-time public orthopaedic surgeon practicing at several major Queensland Hospitals, including Queensland Children's Hospital, Prince Charles Hospital, Ipswich Hospital and Redlands Hospital.

He is skilled in provision of independent medical examinations, workers' compensation claims, and road traffic authority assessments.

Dr Wijenayake attended medical school in QLD and completed his orthopaedic training in several leading Brisbane Hospitals. He spent a further 2 years in subspecialty training in Brisbane and Sydney, as well as an associated fellowship with the college of medical administrators. He is involved in the education of the next generation of surgeons with academic titles at University of QLD, Griffith University and Bond University as well as orthopaedic registrar training. His research has resulted in multiple publications as well as national and international conference presentations.
